CHANGES IN LIBRARY RULES NO. 11 - NO-DEMAND CERTIFICATE

The Committee approved the change in library rule no. 11 after some modifications.

Existing	Proposed
Before taking the annual examination, that is, second, fourth, sixth & eighth semester examination, as may be applicable or terminating connection with the university in mid session for any reason, every member has to return the Library Identity Cards and clear all dues, if any, and obtain a No-Demand Certificate (NDC). No department shall issue examination Roll Nos. to its student without NDC from the Library. Research students will obtain NDC from the library before the submission of dissertations/thesis. No office or department shall issue a discharge certificate to its teachers/non-teaching staff without obtaining a NDC from the University Library. However, NDC's shall not be required before the commencement of first, third, fifth or seventh semester examination.	After two weeks of taking the final year/semester examination as may be applicable or terminating connection with the university in mid session for any reason every member has to return the library identity cards and clear all dues if any and obtain a No-Demand Certificate (NDC) however, after the validity period as specified on the library card the student shall be entitled to borrow two books during preparatory and examination days only. Research students will obtain NDC from the library before the submission of dissertations/thesis. No office or department shall issue a discharge certificate to its teachers/non-teaching staff without obtaining a NDC from the University Library.
