Global Conference on Cyber Space (GCCS) is a prestigious international conference that aims at encouraging dialogue among stakeholders of cyberspace. Goal of GCCS 2017 is to promote an inclusive Cyber Space with focus on policies and frameworks for inclusivity, sustainability, development, security, safety & freedom, technology and partnerships for upholding digital democracy, maximizing collaboration for strengthening security and safety and advocating dialogue for digital diplomacy.

2. India is proud to host the 5th Global Conference on Cyber Space (GCCS) in 2017, one of the world's largest conferences on Cyber Space and related issues. Themed on **Cyber4All: An Inclusive, Sustainable, Developmental, Safe and Secure Cyberspace**, the GCCS 2017 will be inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India **Shri Narendra Modi**. To be held in India for the first time, the two-day conference will see participation of around 2000 delegates from senior Government officials, industry leaders, academia and civil society from over 100 countries. Multiple run-up events are planned across India and abroad to create awareness about GCCS 2017, along with 2 days of pre-event activities right before the conference.

Global Cyber Challenge as a run up event to Global Conference on Cyber Space (GCCS) 2017 is being organised by Cyber Peace Foundation (CPF) and Policy Perspectives Foundation (PPF) under the guidance of National e-Governance Division, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (NeGD-MeitY) and National Critical Information Infrastructure Protection Centre (NCIIPC). The Grand Finale will be organized at GCCS 2017, New Delhi on 20 & 21 November, 2017.
