



**NOTIFICATION**

The Vice-chancellor, on the recommendations dated 12.05.2021 of the committee constituted to suggest relaxation to students in view of COVID-19 pandemic with regards to reduction of syllabus, examination pattern, conduct of examinations etc., has been pleased to allow following amendment in conduct of examinations and reduction of syllabus for students of various UG and PG courses of affiliated degree colleges (i.e. Arts, Commerce, Sciences and Law streams) of the University as under:

1. The examinations of students of 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester of PG courses and 5<sup>th</sup> Semesters of UG courses (Regular as well as Re-appear) in affiliated degree colleges of the university already kept in abeyance will be re-started w.e.f. 18.05.2021 through online mode only. The Controller of Examinations of the University shall notify the rescheduled date-sheet of these examinations for information of the all concerned.
2. The students appearing in above said examinations are required to submit PDFs of their Answer Sheets through prescribed e-mail(s) of their college for these examinations specifically within stipulated period. The students will attempt their examinations on the University designed Answer Sheets, if they already have, or on A-4 size good quality papers. They are also required to submit the original Answer Sheets of their examinations to their colleges within 21 days of opening of their colleges or over the Lockdown period notified by the State Govt., whichever is later. This will help students to resolve many issues arising later on due to communication problem etc.
3. The process of proctoring and monitoring during the above said examinations will be carried by the University with the help of staff of the affiliated colleges.
4. The examinations of students of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester of UG and PG courses of affiliated degree colleges of the university will be conducted simultaneously with 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester of their courses in July/August, 2021 with 50% subjects of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester and 50% of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semesters of their courses as per their choices.
5. Similarly, the examinations of students of 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester of UG courses of affiliated degree colleges of the university will be conducted simultaneously with 4<sup>th</sup> Semester of their courses in July/August, 2021 with 50% subjects of 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester and 50% of 4<sup>th</sup> Semesters of their courses as per their choices.
6. 25% syllabus of Even Semesters of UG and PG courses of affiliated degree colleges of the University commenced through online classes in May, 2021 shall be reduced keeping in view of prevailing pandemic conditions in the State/Country.

7. Result of Even Semesters for which examinations have already been held or average score is to be given will be declared at the earliest preferably in two weeks.
8. Re-appear examinations of pass out students be also held in online manner.
