HARSAC in collaboration with Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology (GJU S&T), Hisar has started four semester full time M.Tech. Course in Geoinformatics (GI) during the academic session 2009-10, which was later approved by the AICTE. The guidelines for grant of HARSAC Merit scholarship to the M.Tech. (Geoinformatics) students are hereby laid down as under:-

I. NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Top 5 (**five**) students in order of merit in each semester of M. Tech (GI) will be provided the **HARSAC Merit cum Means Scholarships** of Rs. 5000 /- per month. (Rs. Five thousand). Starting time of the scholarship will be from the current academic session i.e. 2016-17.

i. Merit Criterion

1. This scholarship will be given to the students studying M. Tech (GI) at HARSAC.
2. To be eligible for the award of HARSAC Merit Scholarship, the students have to obtain at least 60 % marks and a minimum of 80% attendance in the semester. (The scholarship starts from the II semester, and will be awarded based upon the marks obtained during the 1st semester) after fulfilling the criteria.
3. The students should not be involved in any type of indiscipline or unfair means.
4. The students availing scholarship under this scheme cannot avail the benefits of any other scholarships.
5. While finalizing the merit list, if two or more students acquire same marks / GPA, then the younger student will be preferred.
6. Top five students obtaining the highest marks based upon the merit of the 1st semester will be awarded the merit scholarship in the II semester.
7. In the subsequent semesters, the top five students in order of merit based upon the cumulative marks of all the previous semesters will be awarded the Merit-cum -Means - scholarship.

ii. Means Criterion

1. The parental income is the basis for the 'means' criterion of the scholarship. At present, total income of family (both parents of the student) from all the sources should not exceed Rs.4, 50,000 /- (Rs. Four lakh fifty thousand only) per annum.
2. When a student applies for the scholarship for the first time, copy of the Income Certificate issued by the Revenue Officer, not below the rank of Tehsildar or the Income Tax Return (ITR) has to be submitted by the parent or guardian for the preceding year of the application for the scholarship. No fresh income proof will be required for the renewal of the scholarship in the subsequent years, till the completion of the two years.
3. The scholarship is renewed on a yearly basis provided the student fulfils all the terms and conditions for the renewal of the scholarship.
4. A student whose parental income falls below the prescribed limit at any point during the programme (due to the reasons such as retirement of the parent / guardian or due to any unforeseen circumstances) is eligible to be considered for the award of Merit cum Means fellowship from the month in which such situations arises. In this case a fresh Income proof certificate supported by acceptable documentary evidences need to be submitted.

II. MODE OF PAYMENT

1. The payment of scholarship will be made through online transaction into the student account after completion of office/accounts sections formalities/requirements
2. The amount of scholarship will be released only after obtaining the attendance certificate from the M. Tech course Coordinator.
