Rules and Regulations for Poster Making Competition

- Participants will bring their own art material like Poster Colours, Drawing Pins, Pencil, Paint Brushes, Use of Scale and Compass is allowed.
- Drawing Sheets will be provided.
- Topic for the competition is “1.Swachhta 2. Water Conservation and 3. Forest Conservation”.
- The participants should have Identity cards with them.
- The child has to complete his/her poster within 1 ½ hours.
- All drawing sheets will be the whole sole property of the organizers after the competition is over.
- Decision of the judges will be final.
- Caption should be mentioned on the poster. No slogan should be written.
- Reporting time for the competition is 9 A.M.
- Competition will start at 9:30 A.M on dated 28th January, 2020.

Rules and Regulations for Slogan Writing

- Participants will bring their own art material-like Use of any Kind of Colours, Drawing Pins, Pencil, Paint Brushes, Use of Scale and Compass is allowed, No Stencil is allowed.
- Drawing Sheets will be provided.
- Topic for the competition is “1.Swachhta 2. Water Conservation and 3. Forest Conservation”.
- Outlining with any pen or brush is allowed.
- The participants should have Identity Cards with them.
- The child has to complete his/her poster within 1 hour.
- All drawing sheets will be the whole sole property of the organizers after the competition.
- Decision of the judges will be the final.
- The slogan should be in minimum 10 and maximum 15 words.
- Reporting time for the competition is 01:30 p.m.
- Competition will start at 2:00 pm on dated 23rd January, 2020.

Rules and Regulation for Presentation Of Innovative Technologies for Waste Recycling and Energy Conservation Competition

- The registration for the presentation will be from 9:00 a.m. to 9:25 a.m and the competition will start at 9:30 a.m. on 23rd January, 2020
- Duration of the Presentation will be from 7 to 10 minutes only. No extra time will be allowed.
- Slides to be prepared should be from 6 to 8 only.
- The presentation will be judged by a panel of judges. The following will be the criteria of marks for the presentation.
 - Content of the presentation
 - Confidence & Verbal Skill
 - Use of the graphics, sound & Videos
 - Colour Scheme & Background
- Two questions will be asked by the judges as per the theme.
- No plagiarism. The power point Presentation should be the original work of the students.

Rules and Regulation for “Best out of Waste “Competition

- The registration for the presentation will be from 2:00 p.m. to 2:25 p.m and the competition will start at 2:30 p.m. on 27th January, 2020
- Participants will be given 1 hour and 30 mins to show their creativity and 2 minutes to talk about the same.
- The required waste material and stationery like scissor, thread etc. should be brought by the participants.
- Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material or any second hand items that otherwise would be thrown away.
- The material would be rejected if found to be waste product or second hand item.
- No ready or semi-finished model or matter would be accepted from participant in competition.
- Participants will be judged on creativity, utilization of resources, artistic composition & design, eco-friendly rating, utility of the product and overall presentation.
- No mobile or Internet means would be allowed to use at the time of Competitions.
- The decision of the judges will be considered final and abiding.

- One candidate can participate in all activities of Competitions.
- The competition is open for the students of GJUS&T, Hisar only.
